



TiPS - Development Programme for Testing in Polish and Slovene – a Socrates Lingua 2 project

The work on the project was concluded as planned on January 1, 2005. The following final project products related to language test development have been published by one of the project partners – Universitas Publishing House in Kraków, Poland:
